The Canadian MedicAlert Foundation has developed a **free** program to protect children living with chronic medical conditions, allergies or special needs. This program is called No Child Without. It was developed to ensure children across Canada from age 4 to their 14th birthday receive MedicAlert protection at no cost to the parent, school or Board of Education.

Each participating school has No Child Without bar-coded brochures specific to the school. If you are interested in having your child participate in the program, please ask the office staff for a brochure and follow the information provided.

Students will have a choice of identity bracelets, listing their medical conditions and membership number. As a member of MedicAlert, you will receive a wallet card with all of the member's information, access to the 24 Hour Emergency Hotline, notification of personal emergency contact at the time of an emergency and a follow-up with parents after the emergency call has been made to the Hotline. Should your child move to another school in Canada, they are still protected.
