	Each teacher will let students know what their classroom policy is.		
	Students are not permitted to take their personal devices (phones, tablets) outside, so they will		
	maximize their physical activity and socializing time on their Nutrition Break and Lunch Break.		
	We ask students not to have devices out in the hallways between classes for safety and social		
	reasons as well.		
	To minimize disruptions to learning, we also ask that parents do not text or call students on their		
	phones during the day until after 2:45 pm. In case of an emergency, where students need to be		
	contacted, parents are asked to call the Office at 250-477-1878. We realize that some families use		
	personal devices to stay in touch while children go to and from school but want students to be able		
	to focus on school and their learning during the school day. Our main goal is to help students learn		
	to use modern technology in a balanced and healthy manner that supports their learning. We appreciate your support at home in furthering this cause.
