Dear Parents/Guardians:

We will again be introducing our *Digital Citizenship* lessons at all three grade levels this year to help teach students to use technology, the internet, and social media safely and appropriately. This an ongoing challenge as various technologies become more widely available, and with the proliferation of popular social media apps with young people. We believe that this proactive approach is an important part of the overall response needed to guide children through the pressures that digital technology places upon them. However, as I have written before, we cannot do it alone. An even more important part of keeping students safe with technology is

appropriate parent supervision and open conversations at home about the dangers and pitfalls of the internet and social media. We know there are many benefits to these modern tools but please make sure you are knowledgeable about, and monitoring who your child interacts with online. Checking to see if they are practicing safe online habits when online (e.g., not sharing personal information, understanding their digital footprint, etc.) is important as well. As much as we can teach the safe use of technology, much of students' time online may be outside of school. Your help in having regular dialogue with your child about these issues will really support the work we do at school.

New Bleachers in Gym
