Gr. 7 Bike Training Week (Apr 29—May 3):

Just a reminder to all grade seven families that we will be starting our bike training on Monday April 29. Your child will receive three on bike sessions throughout the course of the week and this training is part of our school's focus on sustainable

transportation. This training is also in preparation for our trip to Camp Thunderbird, but all grade seven students are expected to be taking part regardless of whether or not they are taking part in the Camp Thunderbird trip at the end of May. All students are required to have a bike and helmet for this training. If your child does not have one, or both, of these then please see if they can borrow one from a friend. If you are unable to arrange this then please contact your child's advisory teacher or Mr Maxwell (<u>amaxwell@sd61.bc.ca</u>) at the school so we can try to arrange a loaner for this experience. All bikes should be locked up at the school and taken home at the end of the day. If this is not possible and you require that your child leave their bike at the school overnight then please contact Mr. Maxwell and he can try to arrange for them to be stored in our school courtyard for the duration of the week.

We are fortunate to have trainers come from the Victoria Bike to Work Week society and want to thank the AGMS PAC for their continued support of this experience. This year we have also had support from the CRD to ensure this training takes place and to see how we can expand it to our community of schools. As a result we have added another aspect in that our athletic leadership students will be working with students from Frank Hobbs to help them receive some training in bike maintenance and safe riding. This has been a long term goal, to ensure that all students in our community are able to move safely and sustainably through our community, and we are excited about this progression of the program.
