Parent-Teacher Conferences: Wednesday, October 23rd and Thursday, October 24th

This year we will once again be using an online booking system to sign up for our parent-teacher conferences. The website is http://arbutusglobal.schoolappointments.com/. The website will walk you through the registration and booking process. All families will need to create an account since the accounts from last year have been deleted for security purposes. Once bookings are made the times will then be confirmed with an email home. Bookings can be made/changed online using this system from today Friday, October 11 until Monday, October 21 (midnight). After this time period parents will need to contact their child's advisory teacher directly to make any changes or to create new appointments.

Parents are asked to choose a time to meet with their child's advisory teacher as this is the person that oversees your child's academic program.
