Sustainable and Safe Transpiration: Thank you to all parents who are encouraging students to bike or walk to school. Every little bit helps with the environment, and it's a great way for students to be active and physically fit! For those who have to drive your child, please consider using one of the *Drive to 5* drop-off locations in the neighbourhood, including:

- The Lexington Ave. back pathway

Students can then easily walk from these drop-off points, and it also keeps you out of the congestion in our parking lot.
