Covid Protocol if Your Child is Unwell

Rainy Weather: Just a reminder as we approach the rainy season that students should <u>always be</u> <u>bringing a jacket to school</u> for



our outdoor breaks. We typically try and get students outside even if it is raining to enjoy some exercise and fresh air. Rain Days (staying inside) are only called if it is a heavy downpour.



Special Parent Pick-up and Drop-offs

Parents needing to drop students off or pick up early during the school day should continue to use the front

parking lot. Students will make their way into the school or out to your vehicle.

For safety reasons, **please do not drive down the service driveway to the back door**, as there are students using this area to get to and from the playground this year. Thank you!

Please use the new and recently revised *Daily Health Check* form each morning (can be found on our website under "quick links") to ensure your child is healthy and not exhibiting any respiratory symptoms. If any students or staff are sick <u>they must not come to school</u>. This will be essential in keeping our school community safe this winter. Parents must also check with a medical professional or call 811 to ensure their child does not have COVID 19 before they can return to school. Students must also be symptom free before returning to school.

Parent Access to the Building—Parents will not be able to enter the school this year (all exterior doors are locked) and teachers will be communicating with you by phone or video call. In rare and urgent situations in person meetings may be able to be arranged.
