January Interim Reporting: We usually have parents in for *Student-Led Conferences* at the end of January but due to Covid we are planning a safer substitute process to help you stay up to date on your child's learning this year. The early dismissal time for January 27 currently in the 2020-21 calendar will remain in place, but the way we share this information with you will take a different shape this year. More details will come home next week on a substitute process.

FSAs: The Grade 7 Foundational Skills Assessment is scheduled to be completed this year between January 18 and February 26. More details will follow next week on how this will look at Arbutus for Grade 7 students this year.

Grade 6 Middle Years Development Instrument (MDI): Grade 6 parents were notified in December about this social-emotional student survey also happening this month. The MDI questionnaire addresses five areas: **physical health and well-being, connectedness, social and emotional development, school experiences, and use of after-school time.** This will be the third time we have participated in this survey and I always appreciate the rich data that it provides us on the mental well-being of our students. The surveys are anonymous so we do not see individual results, but do get a clear picture of the overall mental health of students in this grade level. This very much helps us with our school goals and growth planning, so we can know which areas to focus on.

Finally, please keep those Daily Health Checks happening every morning so we can continue to keep our school safe this winter. Have a great weekend and stay safe!

This year our registration process will be online. Important dates are as follows:

~ Grade 8's program of choice for grade 9—watch emails regarding each individual schools, being sent from us. Deadline for registration is Jan. 22.

~ Late French Registration for incoming grade 6's—registration is January 25-29. Registration forms will be available closer to registration week. Registration is a lottery system. Deadline is Jan. 29. Forms will not be accepted before Jan. 25.

Parents will be notified the following week regarding placement.

~ Transfer week— Feb 8-11—primarily grade 8's wishing to go to a different high school than their catchment. Also for students who want to change programs-moving from French to English. Also for students in any grade who are wanting to change schools the coming year.

Forms will be available on our District and school websites and in the office for students to pick up closer to transfer week. Forms will not be accepted before Feb. 8.
