


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Dear Arbutus Families,

New Covid Safety Rules at School: The new guidelines were reviewed at a school-wide Zoom assembly this morning, and we began following the new required safety guidelines today. The main changes are:

- Everyone now must wear a mask when standing or moving around indoors, and in PE classes
- Masks are not required when seated at your desk or eating/drinking
- Physical distancing (2 meters) is now required, even in cohorts
- Masks are not a replacement for physical distancing, and students should not be facing each other when seated and spaced apart



As you can see these changes will be challenging at times for students but we will be working hard to enforce them for everyone's safety.

**Volleyball:** I was sorry to have to stop after school volleyball this week due to new guidelines from the Middle School Sports Association, but feel it is the safe thing to do at this time. We hope to start Track and Field outdoors after Spring Break, which should be a safer sport to implement.
