

This year our registration process will be online. Important dates are as follows:

~ Late French Registration for incoming grade 6's—registration is January 25-29. Registration forms will be available on our District website starting Monday morning, January 25th. Registration is a lottery system. Deadline is Jan. 29 at 3:30pm. Forms will not be accepted before Jan. 25.


Attendance - Please remember to inform our Attendance line if your child will be late or absent.
