## THIS WEEK'S REFLECTIONS

This week has been a wonderful week of connecting with staff and students. Ms Weckend and I had the chance to meet in person with many of our Team Avalanche teams (which are made up of 2-3 divisions) to discuss, model, and reinforce our shared values, the most important of which is RESPECT.

With each team, we asked, "What does Respect Look Like, Sound Like, and Feel Like to you?" Students actively engaged in this discussion with their peers, and in sharing out with us. We wrote each team's ideas on poster paper, and we will display these in the center of the school once we have met with all of the teams (we have a couple left this coming week).

It was inspiring to hear students' ideas, such as, "Respect looks like helping others", and "Respect feels like belonging", and "Respect sounds like kind words."

I could go on and on.

We also spoke about the Ripple Effect – the idea that when we as individuals do our best to be our best and make

choices that are supportive of others, that positively impacts those around us – as well as ourselves. When we, for example, treat those around us with respect, that creates a positive ripple out to help our class, team, school, family, and larger community.


We feel very fortunate to have students who demonstrate so much reflection, thoughtfulness and respect, and thank you as their families for guiding them in these values.


# Call out for Coaches!
