## Youth Leaders in Training 2022: Information Sheet

The City of Victoria's Youth Leadership in Training Program (YLIT) consists of 3 parts:

1. One week of leadership training at Crystal Pool
2. Four weeks of placements in summer camps in the City of Victoria
3. Team building out-trips

Applicants must be 14-18 years old with an interest in recreation and/or child & youth care. They are selected in an interview process that consists of initiative tasks, questions and scenarios. At the end of the program YLITs receive a \$500 honorarium for the completion of the program as well as a certificate and a reference letter.

The leadership training at YLIT has a focus on recreation leadership skills as well as public speaking, teamwork, communication and many other important life skills. The skills learned and practiced in the training are transferable and provide a sound basis for future employment in any field. YLIT is a great 'first-job' opportunity, but also accepts students with prior work experience who want to expand their skill set. The environment at Crystal Pool is fun, supportive, and stimulating with a mix of classroom, outdoors, and practical training.

Training runs for 1 week (July 4-July 8). The placements (working in camp settings) are for the next 4 weeks of the summer (between July 11 and August 5).

**Applications are due by June 24 but will close earlier as positions are filled. Applicants must include the application form, and a resume is accepted, but not required.**
